## Benefit Details

The FCC Emergency Broadband Benefit temporarily provides eligible families:

Up to \$50/month  
discount for  
broadband service

Up to \$75/month  
discount for  
households on  
qualifying Tribal  
lands

One-time discount  
of up to \$100 for  
a laptop, desktop,  
or tablet bought  
through a  
participating  
program

## Am I Eligible?

If any of these criteria apply to  
anyone in your home, you're eligible!

- 1 Has an income at or below 135% of the Federal Poverty Line or participates in certain government assistance programs;
- 2 Receives benefits under the free- and reduced-price school lunch or breakfast program;
- 3 Received a Federal Pell Grant during the current award year;
- 4 Experienced a substantial loss of income due to job loss or furlough since February 29, 2020; **or**
- 5 Meets the eligibility criteria for a participating provider's existing low-income or COVID-19 program.

## 3 Ways to Apply

### 1 Contact Your Provider

Ask your provider if they participate in the EBB, or use the FCC's online tool to find a participating provider nearby.
