HOSTING THE NORTH CAROLINA POVERTY SIMULATION EXPERIENCE

During the Simulation, participants assume the role of a low-income individual or family member and are tasked with navigating the complexities of life in poverty. Family roles are based on real scenarios and challenges faced by low-income households. Through this experiential learning experience, participants emerge with a greater understanding of what it means to live in poverty America.

You Organization Will Need To:

- Secure an event space (around 3,000 sq. ft. is ideal)
 - Have a minimum of 50 and no more than 80 participants
- Have an additional 22 volunteers to participate as community service providers
- Provide approximately 12 tables and 100 chairs
- Reserve 4 hours for the entire event (volunteer orientation, participant registration, a simulated month in poverty, and a debriefing session)
- Make a budgetary contribution of \$1,500 or \$2,500 (member or non-member rate) plus travel expenses

The NC Community Action Association Will Provide:

- At least 3 Poverty Simulation Facilitators (to provide all on-site set-up, facilitation and debriefing)
